

The history of the wall:

This beautiful wall and memorial area were dedicated in 2000. It began with generous donations from the family of an area resident and avid softball player.

Michael "Smitty" Smith could be found at the park seven days a week in the summer. He may have been playing, watching, cheering, or coaching, but his summer life was the ballfield.

His family's wish was to have some type of memorial in the park to honor, not only him, but anyone in our community.

A committee was formed and with the donations from the Smith Family, funds from Park-O-Rama and the cooperation of the Village, the wall and garden were created.

Each year, a ceremony is held to dedicate the names of those placed on the wall during the previous year.

Today, we have over 150 nameplates on the wall and the quote in the middle says it all:

Not because someone is gone
But because someone was here*
