- **Curfew-** No person under the age of 16 is allowed to loiter in the village between 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Persons 16 and 17 years of age are not allowed to loiter in the village between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. This Ordinance #509.08 is enforced by the Fulton County Sherriff's Department.
- **Dog Owners-** Please pick up after your pet when they do their duty. Animals are not permitted to run at large upon any public place and/or property. This includes inside the baseball park fences. Please keep your pet on a leash when outside or in an unenclosed yard.
- **Parking-** No motor vehicle, camper, RV or trailer should be parked on any street or alley in the village without moving for a period longer than 48 hours. (Zoning Code 351.14 & Ordinance #987).

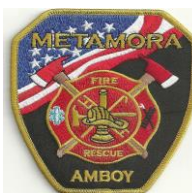
