Curbside Bulk Item Pickup- Saturday, September 23rd Place bulk items at the curb in an orderly fashion no earlier than Thursday evening prior to pick up and no later than 7:00 a.m. the day of service.

Acceptable: Furniture, mattresses, box springs, white goods, scrap metal and carpeting (10 roll limit). All trash should be easily handled by 2 people. Nothing over 5 foot long.

Not Acceptable: Refrigerators, air conditioners, yard waste, tires, batteries, hazardous waste, concrete, construction, or demolition material. Freon will be assessed a \$25 fee and must be scheduled by calling 419-826-6655. Regular garbage will NOT be picked up during the Curbside Bulk Item Pickup. Do NOT bring in items from family members who DO NOT live in the village.

Yard Assistance- If you need help with yard cleanup, please contact the village office at (419) 644-2051 and they will get you in contact with the Chamber for assistance thru their community service program.
